# NR28 National Scout Regatta - FEES

## Fees Background

- The Regatta Organising Committee have built what we believe to be a fair and reasonable budget, and this has been approved by ScoutsNZ NEC.
- As part of the budgeting, we have worked to reduce the adult leader fee down to \$100. You, along with us, are already giving generously of your time and energy to the youth and your groups; to charge you for the privilege seems rather harsh.

## Regatta Fees

- The Regatta Organising Committee are pleased to announce that the youth fee for National Scout Regatta 28 is set at NZD\$510.00
  - Youth Scouts and Venturers attending the regatta in regatta contingents \$510
  - Leaders with regatta contingents \$100

## For funding / grant application purposes.

- The Scout Association is the sole provider of the event and therefore alternate quotes are not available. The breakdown for the youth fee of \$510 is -
- Scout / Venturer - Youth Fee Total \$510
  - Breakdown for funding:
    - Programme & Activities \$133
    - Site Hire & Development \$63
    - Management & Overheads \$130
    - Catering \$174
    - Health & Safety \$ 10

## Accounting Process

- We are using an accounting system for this Regatta which will enable us to invoice for fees. We will be invoicing Regatta Troops on the basis of the number of scouts and leaders registered:
  - 30 June - Deposit \$100 per person registered
  - 30 September - Full fee less deposit for those registered at 30 Sept
  - 30 November - Wash-up invoice covering registrations after 30 Sept
- Each invoice will be payable on the 20th of the month following the date of the invoice i.e. 20 July, 20 Oct and 20 December. (We intend to open Registrations 01 June and close it 30 November)
